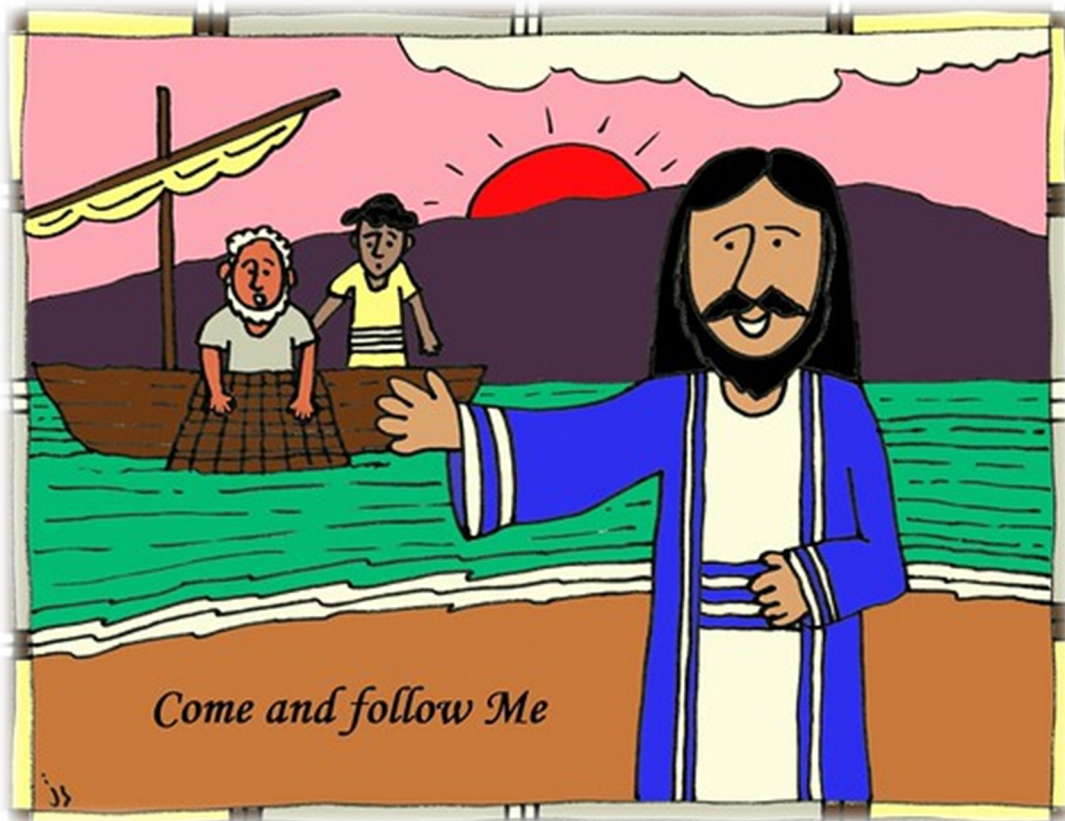

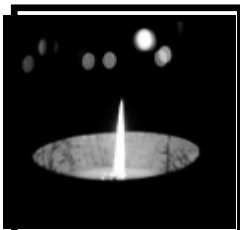

COVID SAFE REMINDERS: Dear Parishioners, a reminder when attending St. Andrew's Sunday service and signing in, **your signature is required** to confirm that you are not currently awaiting COVID test results, have not been in contact in the last 14 days with a COVID positive person or been in a COVID hotspot. The Parish must continue to maintain social distancing, so **if you sign in at the porch entrance**, you need to **sit on the lectern side** of the church. If you **sit in a pew near the Lady Chapel/ kitchen side**, you should **enter and sign in via the Hall entrance**. 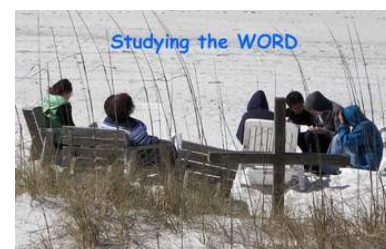
