ANGLICAN CHURCH SOUTHERN Q'LAND – COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY

We have recently been advised by the Diocese that in line with the latest information from Government and health authorities, there is now a mandatory requirement for all who have roles or provide services in our parishes (including readers, musicians, cleaners, gardeners, AV personnel, LA's, morning tea workers etc) to be fully vaccinated against COVID – 19. People undertaking these roles will need to provide evidence of their vaccination status. Please see Rev'd Jeanette or Rev'd Tony, church wardens or members of the Safety Committee to provide this information or to provide evidence of the need for a possible exemption.

LECTIONARY COMMENTARY

This week's gospel reading describes Jesus' miracle of turning the water into wine at the wedding banquet. Again, in our Sunday readings, we are given evidence of Jesus as the Messiah. Previously, we have seen Jesus at his baptism being recognised by God as 'My son, in whom I am well pleased' and through the visit of the wise men from the East who come to pay homage, we see their recognition of Jesus as the Messiah. The miracle at the wedding in Cana gives us further evidence of Jesus' divinity. At this banquet, the freely flowing wine is a sign of God's abundance and the fulfilment and happiness available to the

people of God. Mary signals to her son, Jesus, the predicament of the bridegroom when the wine is running short. Mary is sensitively aware of the situation, draws Jesus' attention to the fact and has confidence in his ability to solve the problem. In this story, Mary is seen not only as the mother of Jesus but she also represents the Church – the community of Christ. It is through this community that Jesus comes to us. As we share love, care, compassion and concern we demonstrate the love of God to others.

These are troubled times in our community and in the world. More and more of us are being affected by the pandemic as we hear of friends, family and community members who have contracted COVID. We, as leaders of our church community are very aware of these challenges as we plan to do whatever is necessary to attempt to keep everyone safe. Recent changes that we are implementing (following Diocesan guidelines) are mask wearing in church gatherings and mandatory vaccination or exemption requirements for those with roles in our churches.

This week, we received a letter from the ACSQ bishops suggesting that we restrict face to face committee meetings (eg Parish Council) and revert to ZOOM meetings as an alternative. At this stage, we plan to keep running church services live and by Zoom. We will also make plans to provide for ministry to continue if parishioners in key positions become ill or are in close contact with someone who becomes sick. Above all, we need to ensure that pastoral care is a priority. Keeping connected (by phone and internet) and providing love and care to each other is so important in these troubled times.

May God's love and peace sustain you and the loving care of your Church family support you as we travel through this next lap of the COVID marathon.
